This wine showcases a deep ruby-red color, hinting at its intensity and complexity. Awarded by Luca Maroni with 99 points starting from its first vintage, it embodies the heart and love of the family.

BOUQUET

Intense aromas of ripe red berries, black cherries, and plums, interwoven with notes of warm spices, vanilla, and a touch of oak.

The palate is smooth and well-rounded, with silky tannins and a harmonious balance between the nose and mouth. Flavors of dark fruit, chocolate, and spice unfold gracefully, leading to a long, refined finish.
