BACKGROUND:

Caballero de Blanca Luna means "The White Moon Knight", this Knight is Sansón Carrasco, a Don Quixote character. He believes that by providing Quixote with adventures, he will make the "knight" tire of chivalric pursuits. Carrasco is a key character and finally is the cause of Quixote's return home.

This organic wine represents the tradition and winemaking history as well as the modern means of a sustainable agriculture.

PRODUCTION AREA:

In the province of Cuenca near central Spain, our vineyard is located in an area where wine culture has been around for decades. It sits at an altitude of 800 meters above sea level. The continental Mediterranean climate of this territory brings plenty of sunlight to the vineyard, and the clay soil retains water, essential for the health of the vines.

VINIFICATION AND SERVING:

This wine is produced from our Estate-grown grapes, which are organically grown. They are night harvested and cold macerated before the fermentation process begins. We recommend service at 8°C. You can pair it with grilled or fried fish, for example grilled sardines, calamari or octopus.

TASTING NOTES:

A golden hue with green notes. Fruity citrus and pear aromas with light tropical notes on the nose. Good acidity and long finish.
