## BACKGROUND:

Caballero de Blanca Luna means "The White Moon Knight", this Knight is Sansón Carrasco, a Don Quixote character. He believes that by providing Quixote with adventures, he will make the "knight" tire of chivalric pursuits. Carrasco is a key character and finally is the cause of Quixote's return home. This organic wine represents the tradition and winemaking history as well as the modern means of a sustainable agriculture.

## PRODUCTION AREA:

In the province of Cuenca near central Spain, our vineyard is located in an area where wine culture has been around for decades. It sits at an altitude of 800 meters above sea level. The continental Mediterranean climate of this territory brings plenty of sunlight to the vineyard, and the clay soil retains water, essential for the health of the vines.

## VINIFICATION AND SERVING:

This wine is produced with organically grown grapes. It is previously macerated for one day at a temperature of 7°C, then it is raised steadily to 15°C during the fermentation period. We recommend service at 16°C. For a great combination, try this wine with a chicken paella or beef ribs.

## TASTING NOTES:

Nice cherry color with a violet shade. Red berries and cherry bouquet.  
Fresh and harmonious with long finish on the palate.
